Luxair plans to operate a total of 101 destinations throughout 2026, with 97 of them available during the summer season, running from 29 March and 24 October 2026. The summer program includes nine additional routes, carefully selected to meet growing demand for sun destinations, cultural getaways, and off-the-beaten-path adventures, reaffirming Luxair's role as Luxembourg's gateway to the world.

Whether you're planning a beach holiday, a cultural city trip, or a scenic escape, Summer 2026 brings more flexibility, more direct routes, and more reasons to book early. All flights are operated by Luxair aircraft, with frequencies tailored to passenger preferences, offering seamless travel and premium service from booking to arrival. Alicante (Spain) – RELAUNCH

Start: 1 April 2026 | Operates: Every Wednesday and Saturday

Spain is one of Luxair's key markets, and the relaunch of flights to Alicante – last served between 2017 and 2018 – reflects the airline's intent to further strengthen its Iberian offering. Previously accessible via Madrid through Luxair's partnership with Iberia, Alicante will now benefit from a direct connection, offering passengers a smoother and more time-efficient journey.

Located on the Costa Blanca, Alicante combines sun, sea, and Spanish heritage. Highlights include Santa Bárbara Castle with its panoramic views, the lively Explanada de España, and easy access to nearby resorts like Benidorm and Altea. With two weekly flights, this vibrant destination is now within even easier reach for both beach lovers and culture seekers.

Girona (Spain) – NEW

Start: 2 June 2026 | Operates: Every Tuesday and Saturday (High Season Only)

Girona, in northeastern Catalonia, is a historic city known for its medieval charm, vibrant cultural scene, and proximity to the scenic Costa Brava. Visitors can stroll along ancient city walls, explore

the Gothic cathedral and the well-preserved Jewish Quarter, or use the city as a gateway to beaches, cliffs, fishing villages, and renowned golf resorts. The Luxembourg–Girona route will operate twice a week from 2 June to 29 August 2026, offering flexible options for both short and extended stays. Bilbao (Spain) – RELAUNCH

Start: 16 July 2026 | Operates: Every Thursday and Sunday

In response to long-standing demand from the Spanish community, the relaunch of Bilbao opens the door to one of Spain's most dynamic and distinctive regions. Up to now, Bilbao has been served via connecting flights through Madrid as part of Luxair's cooperation with Iberia. The upcoming direct flights provide a faster, more convenient option for both leisure and business travelers.

As the cultural capital of northern Spain, Bilbao is known for its striking mix of modern and traditional, from the iconic Guggenheim Museum to the lively Casco Viejo and its famous pintxos. The Basque Country offers a rich cultural identity, world-renowned gastronomy, and easy access to beaches and hiking trails, all within close reach of the city. This route will be operated twice weekly on Thursdays and Sundays and ensures again a direct connection between Luxembourg and the Basque Country, a region that combines strong economic relevance with growing appeal as a leisure destination.

Porto Santo (Portugal) – NEW

Start: 31 March 2026 | Operates: Every Tuesday

Porto Santo will complement Luxair's existing Madeira service as a second Atlantic destination, offering a quieter, more nature-focused alternative to Funchal. Part of the Madeira archipelago, the island is gaining popularity among individual travelers and families and marks a targeted expansion of Luxair's Portugal portfolio. Its 9-kilometer stretch of golden sand, renowned for its therapeutic properties, makes it ideal for those seeking relaxation without the crowds. Largely untouched by mass tourism, Porto Santo offers cozy hotels, scenic walking trails, and authentic local dining. The route is also expected to resonate with Luxembourg's Portuguese community, reinforcing strong cultural ties between both regions.

Zakynthos and Araxos (Greece) – NEW

Start: 20 May 2026 | Operates: Every Wednesday (combined flight)

Greece remains one of Luxair's strongest leisure markets. With Zakynthos and Araxos, the airline is set to open two new regions, complementing its existing network in the country. Their inclusion supports Luxair's strategy of expanding established markets in a targeted manner while continuously diversifying its offering.

Zakynthos, part of the Ionian Islands, is one of Greece's most photogenic destinations, famous for its turquoise waters, dramatic cliffs, and the iconic Navagio (Shipwreck) Beach. The island is also home to Laganas Bay, a protected marine park where endangered loggerhead turtles come to nest. Visitors can explore the Blue Caves, taste fresh local cuisine in mountain villages, or simply unwind on sandy beaches. With authentic charm and natural beauty, Zakynthos is a perfect match for both couples and families. Weekly service from Luxembourg now brings this Greek island paradise within easy reach.

Araxos Airport is the gateway to Greece's western Peloponnese, a region rich in ancient history, long sandy beaches, and traditional Greek culture. From here, travelers can easily visit Ancient Olympia, the birthplace of the Olympic Games, or explore the port city of Patras with its vibrant markets and historic architecture. This is a destination for those who want to go deeper into authentic Greece, without the crowds. Seaside tavernas, archaeological sites, and warm hospitality make Araxos a standout for culture-focused travelers. From 20 May 2026, Luxair will open this

lesser-known region with a weekly direct connection, operated in combination with Zakynthos.

With its mix of heritage, coastal charm, and growing culinary scene, the city is now comfortably reconnected with Luxembourg twice a week.
