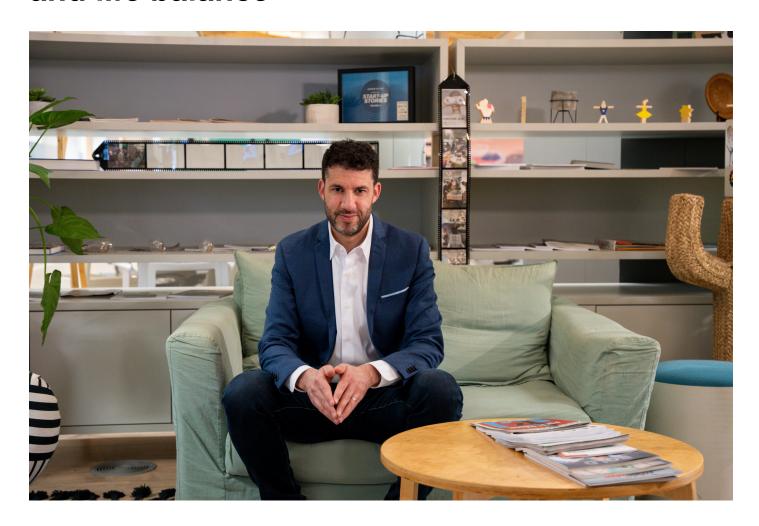
YourldealOffice: reinventing 'remote work' and life balance

How did your idea come about?

After years of working in both corporate environments and the hospitality industry, I saw two trends colliding: the rise of remote work and employees' desire for more meaningful experiences. Too many people work from home in conditions that are far from ideal. We realised that companies could easily offer better alternatives by using underused hospitality venues as occasional workplaces. That's how YourldealOffice was born.

Why now?

Remote and hybrid work are here to stay – although the amount varies – companies still struggle to make them sustainable and attractive. Talents expect more than just a laptop at home. They want flexibility without isolation. Employers, meanwhile, need practical solutions to foster engagement and keep teams productive and loyal. Our solution ticks all these boxes with minimal effort for HR teams.

Why Luxembourg?

Luxembourg is the perfect place for an idea like ours: it's international, open to innovation, and home to companies that truly care about talent retention and well-being. Its workforce is highly mobile, with many cross-border commuters who need flexibility. We also benefit from a strong hospitality network, ideal for hosting our partner venues.

What is the next step?

We are expanding our network of unique work-friendly venues across Europe with a strong presence in France and growing our partnerships with companies who want to stand out with meaningful benefits.
